

**NOISE CONDITIONS FOR CONCERTS HELD
AT THE NORTH SHORE EVENTS CENTRE**

During previous events there have been complaints from local residents regarding excessive noise and this has been supported by an Environment Court decision in 2006.

The Trust has engaged Marshall Day Consultants to advise on this issue and it is now a requirement that event organisers must ensure the following guidelines are adhered to in order to stay within the District plan noise regulations .

Bands (and other activities) shall not exceed the following noise levels inside the stadium;

Mon-Sat 0700-2000hrs L10 102 dBA and L10 104 dB at 63Hz Octave

Mon-Sat 2000-2300hrs L10 97 dBA and L10 99 dB at 63Hz Octave

All other times (inc Sundays) L10 92 dBA and L10 94 dB at 63Hz Octave

At the above levels we are able to meet the North Shore City Council District plan levels as set out below.
